SURREY TO CELEBRATE KHALSA DAY WITH 2016 VAISAKHI PARADE

SURREY, BC – The annual Vaisakhi Parade, taking place on **April 23, 2016**, will once again host a lively and celebratory event to mark the birth of the Sikh faith, pay tribute to the harvest and commemorate one of the most important days in the Sikh calendar, the creation of the Khalsa. The Khalsa was founded to fight adversity over 300 years ago and has since continued to be at the heart of Sikhism. Vaisakhi is celebrated worldwide to recognize the evolvment and importance of this heroic group of people.

The event has been held in Surrey for the past 17 years bringing together over 250,000 people in the largest Khalsa Day Parade held outside of India. It is an occasion of performance, live music, decorated floats and food and drink complimentary of local residents and businesses. The annual Vaisakhi Parade invites people of all cultures and religions to experience the joyous day and savor the unique food and entertainment.

Parade Route: The Khalsa Day Parade is scheduled to begin at approximately 9:00am at the Gurdwara Sahib Dasmesh Darbar, located at 12885-85 Avenue. The Parade will conclude there at approximately 5:00pm (see map for route).

Main Stage Timeline:

- 11:00am-11:45am - traditional Sikh hymn singers
- 11:45am-12:45pm - ceremony honoring community volunteers
- 12:45pm-1: 30pm - speaker series
